02 September 2024 - H.E. Ambassador Maria Lumen B. Isleta hosted the 35th ASEAN Committee in Stockholm meeting, on 30 August 2024 (Friday), held at the Philippine Embassy, Stockholm, Sweden.

The Philippines, which took over as Chair of the Committee on 01 July 2024, led the meeting - that included organization of the agenda as well as the proposed work program of the Committee under its Chairmanship. The meeting thus undertook the adoption of the minutes of the 33rd and 34th Meetings of the ACS (under Thailand's Chairmanship); discussion on the ACS meeting with the Governor of the Riksbank; as well as the individual activities of the ACS planned for the second half of 2024.

The other ASEAN Ambassadors took up the challenge of playing project leads for the different activities which include possible visits and meetings related to nuclear power, waste management and artificial intelligence (AI) in Sweden.

The ACS Ambassadors, who were joined by their respective members of the Technical Working Group (TWG) were treated to a Fika treat consisting of Filipino delicacies, such as biko, maja blanca, and empanada. END.
